Dear Labyrinth Friends,

Here we have made available for downloading free of charge 16 sheets that are suitable for making four poster display units. A typical presentation is shown to the right, mounted on 20" x 30" half-inch thick foam core board. The header sheet is 4 1/4" high and the four full sheets are normal letter size of 8 1/2" x 11". The margins on all sides of the individual sheets are one inch wide, with 3/4" remaining at the top, above the header.

The PDF files for the entire set include the following: Posters1, Posters2, Posters3, Posters4, Headers, Contents, and Instructions (this sheet). If you download our files, we ask only that you send us an email identifying yourself, so we know where our posters go. They are protected by copyright and cannot be used for commercial purposes or resale. We welcome you to use them in PowerPoint presentations or in public displays to inform people about labyrinths.

To mount the sheets, put strips of double-stick tape around the perimeter of the back of each sheet. If you pull the tape too tight and accidentally cause the paper to draw up into a wrinkle, use an Exacto knife to cut through the tape and then gently flatten the sheet. Or use removable tape. Position the sheets by placing two one-inch-wide rulers (or strips of cardboard) in the side and bottom margins of each sheet, forming a 90-degree corner. Then, take a sheet with the tape on the back and place it so it snugs up against both rulers, thereby assuring that the margins are exactly one inch and that the sheet is properly aligned.. The header is 11" wide, leaving 4 1/2" on either side for it to be centered.

In the event that you don't have the time or inclination to make these sheets into poster displays, you can put them in plastic sleeves in a three-ring binder. In that way, people can look through the binder and read the material. These materials have been provided free of cost as a way for us to serve the labyrinth community and at the same time remind people of our presence. We promote labyrinths in other ways, as well, such as our extensive website that has 300 links to labyrinth-related sites. If you have a website that includes photos and information about your labyrinth, please check to see that you are included in our links. To do this, use the search feature. If not, please contact us with the appropriate details so that we can include you in our links.
